TITLE: Program Manager – Youth & Community Programs

SUMMARY: Just Communities seeks a Program Manager to oversee our Youth and Community-Based Programming. Qualified candidates should have prior experience working with high school age youth, a strong commitment to social justice, an ability to work with diverse groups of individuals in inclusive and empowering ways, and be bilingual (Spanish & English). KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- □ Manage, staff, and lead core Just Communities' youth programs, including a residential summer social justice leadership institute (the *CommUnity Leadership Institute*):
 - o Curriculum design and development
 - Arrange and serve as primary liaison to program site
 - o Coordinate public relations, marketing and recruitment efforts
 - o Recruit, train, and direct program volunteers
 - Manage program expenses as directed by approved program budgets
 - Program evaluation
 - o All other tasks related to the successful implementation of programs
- □ Provide on-going formal and informal support, coaching, mentorship, and guidance to youth program graduates, empowering them to foster change in their own lives, their schools, and communities.
- □ Facilitate other Just Communities programs as assigned by Executive Director.
- Recruit, train, and maintain a strong, diverse, and deep pool of volunteer/contract staff capable of staffing and facilitating Just Communities and Just Communities' programs.
- Document all program planning, policies, procedures, practices, and logistics to ensure quality control and sustainability of programs.
- □ Support organizational fundraising by providing information and connections to Development staff & consultants.
- □ Serve as a liaison to at least one Board Committee.
- **Q** Represent Just Communities in the community, especially in areas that relate to program responsibilities.
- Perform additional duties designated by Executive Director to achieve success of programs and meet mission of Just Communities.

- □ Excellent verbal and written communication skills, including the ability to communicate effectively with diverse individuals and groups.

- A familiarity and understanding of issues of diversity, equity, oppression, and social justice especially those issues around which Just Communities programs. Familiarity of such issues facing individuals and communities in CA's Central Coast a plus.
- □ Ability/knowledge of group dynamics, facilitation and training.
- Ability to manage time in order to coordinate multiple tasks.
- □ Ability to work in a team environment and independently.
- □ Willingness and flexibility to engage in weekend and week-long residential programs.
- □ Must have own car (or reliable transportation), valid driver's license and auto liability insurance.
- □ BA or equivalent in a related field preferred, minimum of 1 year experience in program administration and work in the fields of education and/or organization development.
