

IMMEDIATE RELEASE SANTA BARBARA-SANTA MARIA-GOLETA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Santa Barbara County)

The unemployment rate in the Santa Barbara County was 8.9 percent in August 2010, down from a revised 9.1 percent in July 2010, and above the year-ago estimate of 8.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 12.4 percent for California and 9.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
